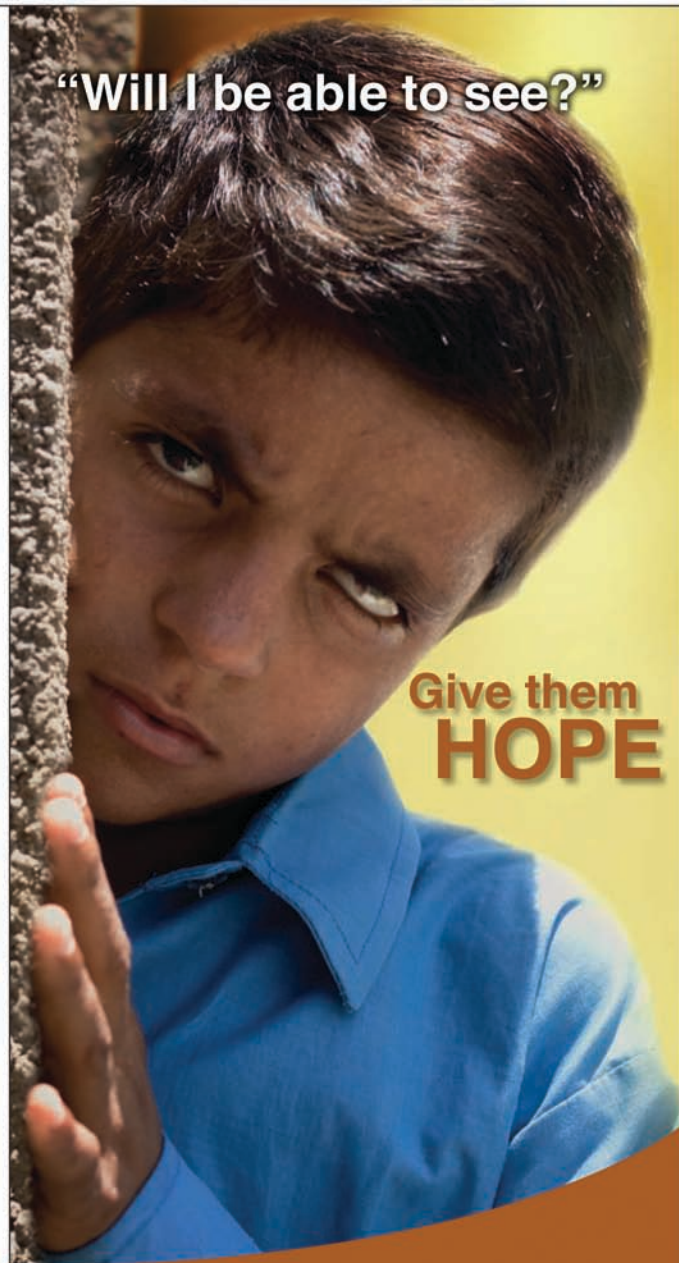

11 year old Fazlur Rehman was in the first grade when he lost his vision. He damaged his cornea while playing and required a corneal transplant to see again.

However his father, Ghulam Mustafa, a factory worker earning just Rs. 8000 a month and with five more children to feed was far too poor to afford the Rs. 100,000 being demanded by a private doctor. Lost in darkness with no hope, LRBT turned out to be Fazlur Rehman's salvation.

LRBT's achievements at a glance:

- 17 State-of-the-Art Free Eye Hospitals and 48 Community Eye Health Centres spread in a manner that no Pakistani is a 3 hour bus ride away from an LRBT facility.
- 25 Million Patients treated in OPD
- Over 2.3 Million People given the gift of Sight through Sight Restoration Surgeries.
- Provides FREE treatment to 1 out of every 3 patients who seek eye care in Pakistan.

However, there is a huge amount to do:

- There are still 1.7 million blind people in the country
- Another 17 million people have impaired vision
- Causing a loss of Rs. 69 billion to our GDP

But there is a Ray of Hope:

- 85% of blindness is curable
