Muhammad Ismail

53 Millionth Patient of LRBT - Muhammad Ismail able to earn again...



In the heart of the bustling city of Karachi, amidst the struggles of poverty, there lived a 32-year-old man named Muhammad Ismail. Born into a poor family, Ismail carried the weight of responsibility on his shoulders. He had five sisters and a younger brother who relied on him for their livelihood. Their humble abode was a rented house with a monthly rent of 12,000 rupees, a burden that seemed insurmountable. Life had dealt them a difficult hand, and Ismail knew he had to work tirelessly to cover their meager monthly expenses.

For years, Ismail toiled away in a furniture shop, diligently polishing and repairing furniture. However, over the past few months, he had noticed a growing difficulty in his vision. His right eye no longer served him as it once did. The prospect of seeking medical treatment was daunting, as he simply could not afford the cost. Despair settled in his heart as he wondered how he would manage the expenses of his own treatment, let alone provide for his beloved family.



As time passed, Ismail's vision deteriorated further, impairing his ability to carry out his daily work. Eventually, he had no choice but to leave his job, leaving his family in a dire situation. Their financial burdens multiplied, for his father too was unwell and unable to contribute. Ismail sought help from various doctors, desperately hoping for a solution. It was then that the harsh reality struck him: he was diagnosed with cataracts in both of his eyes.

Overwhelmed by the weight of his circumstances,

Ismail felt a deep sorrow. His entire family depended on him, and now his vision stood as a barrier to their survival. In this time of darkness, a glimmer of hope emerged through the words of a trusted friend. "You should visit LRBT," his friend advised, "They will help you with your eye possibly without any cost."

Filled with a mix of anticipation and trepidation, Ismail made his way to the LRBT Korangi eye hospital. Upon arrival, the doctors carefully examined him and confirmed the need for cataract surgery. Despite his fears, Ismail placed his trust in the skilled hands of the medical professionals. Ismail found the Staff and Doctors to be polite and caring towards him and the other patients. The day of the surgery arrived, and as the operation proceeded, Ismail could feel a weight being lifted from his weary soul.

When the bandage was finally opened a few days after the surgery, a renewed clarity greeted him. Tears of gratitude welled up, for LRBT had not only restored his vision but also given him the opportunity to regain his employment and once again become a productive member of society. Ismail's heart overflowed with appreciation for the organization that had supported him during his darkest hour.

With his sight restored, Ismail eagerly returned to work, determined to provide for his family once more. He was full of prayers for LRBT, and expressed them with a heartfelt sentiment: "meri duaa hai ke LRBT aur taraqqi karay. Ghareebon ki madad karne ka Allah iss ko aur mauqa de" (I pray that LRBT flourishes – may Allah give LRBT more opportunity to help the poor.)

In the face of adversity, Ismail had found the strength to carry on. His gratitude towards LRBT was visible, for he had been given the gift of sight and the ability to continue supporting his family. As he returned to work, a newfound sense of purpose filled his heart.

COPING WITH THE EVER-GROWING PATIENT VOLUME

LRBT started off as a small mobile unit in Tando Bago over **37** years ago. Over the years, it has spread throughout the country with **19 hospitals** and **55 primary eye care** and **5 outreach clinics**. The journey of growth and expansion continues.

Rahim Yar Khan | New Hospital



The ground-breaking of LRBT RYK hospital took place on 25th June 2022, and it is scheduled for completion in June 2024. The project is progressing satisfactorily, with an overall completion rate of 55% at this time. At the present pace of work, the project is expected to be completed by the end of the first quarter of next year well ahead of the original completion date. The hospital building's two-floor structure (slabs) and basement work have been completed, and the basement (Car parking) and ground floor brick masonry and plaster work are in progress.

Out of a total of 6 residences, electric and plumbing works in four residences are underway. The remaining two residences' ground floor slab formwork is progressing as per plan.

This project is being executed through full financial support from a UAE-based donor who has previously sponsored major renovations and expansions at the Khanewal and Gambat hospitals. Subsequently, the donor funded the construction of a new OPD and surgical complex at Lar, as well as a new hospital building at Mandra, which was completed last year. We are deeply indebted to the family for their unwavering support in assisting underprivileged patients across Pakistan.

PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENTS

LRBT gives credit to its partners for its success and is proud to work with them on ongoing projects:

Sightsavers



Sightsavers, in collaboration with LRBT, aims to reduce the cataract backlog and improve the Cataract Surgical Rate(CSR) in Balochistan. Under a partnership agreement with LRBT, a total of 6,853 cataract surgeries are planned to be conducted at Sibi for the population residing in the peripheral areas of Quetta, Gwadar and Turbat, in south western coast of Balochistan over a period of three years. Starting from January 2023, the service focus is exclusively on Sibi. During the April-June 2023 period, 66 surgeries were performed in Sibi. This makes 3854 the cumulative number of surgeries performed so far.

In a related development, 2,200 sight restoring cataract surgeries have been sponsored by Sightsavers, which are being performed at LRBT Khanewal Hospital during this calendar year. During the quarter under review, 500 surgeries were performed at Khanewal, bringing the cumulative total of surgeries to 950.

Brien Holden Foundation



For the quarter of April to June 2023, LRBT organized OPDs for 72,802 children, out of which 5,629 underwent refraction. As part of the "Our Children's Vision" (OCV) Campaign, LRBT provided 1,479 glasses to children in need. Additionally, LRBT collaborates with BHF to operate 7 optical shops at LRBT Hospitals located in Korangi, Gambat, Lar, Multan Road Lahore, Mandra, Shahpur, and Akora Khattak. These optical shops align with the charitable mission of LRBT and BHF, offering affordable, high-quality eyewear to visitors.

All optical shops are situated within the hospital

premises and utilize modern equipment for lens shaping and frame fixing. Furthermore, an additional shop will be inaugurated at the Rahimyar Khan hospital when it becomes operational in June 2024.

In addition to the above initiatives, LRBT and BHF are collaborating on a research study titled "Effectiveness of Optical Shop Models in Pakistan." This project will run from 1st March 2023 to 30th April 2024.

The research results will provide opportunities to advocate for quality standards in refraction and optical dispensing and enable improved planning to strengthen standard refractive/optical services.

CBM International



LRBT is implementing a multi-interventional Inclusive Eye Health project titled "Strengthening of Inclusive Eye Care Services in Rahim Yar Khan District" in collaboration with Christian Blind Mission (CBM) and the College of Ophthalmology & Allied Vision Services (COAVS). This project was launched in January 2021 and is set to reach maturity in December 2024.

Updates on the project activities:

- **Eye Screening** - A total of 20,661 people were screened, with 5,660 at Basic Health Units, 5,659 at Rural Health Centres, and 9,342 at Tehsil Head Quarter Hospital.
- **School Screening** - During the reporting period 1,308 school children were screened, and among them, 125 children were identified with vision problems and referred to RHC for further examination and treatment.
- **Training of Health Staff** - A total of 13 project

staff received refresher training in collecting Disability Disaggregated data and Safeguarding.

- **Eye Care Services Provision** - Under the project, a total of 4,600 spectacles were prescribed, and 1,057 spectacles were provided free of cost to needy patients. Additionally, 70 cataract surgeries were performed at THQ Hospital, Sadiqabad, and 5 low vision aids were provided to patients. To address the need for cataract surgeries, 500 Cataract surgical kits were provided to THQ Hospital Khanpur.

- **Quarterly Review Meetings with OPDs and SHGs** - Progress review meetings with Self Help Groups and potential groups for Organization for Persons with Disabilities were organized. A total of 21 SHGs were gathered, and their performance and needs were assessed.

- **District Inclusive Eye Health Committee Meeting and Development of District Inclusive Eye Health Plan** - A two-day consultative workshop was held on 21-22 June 2023 for the development of the district inclusive eye health plan 2023-2026 in Rahimyar Khan, Punjab

- **International Events/Celebration:** - During the reporting period, different International days related to eye care were celebrated, including Myopia Awareness Week and World Hand Hygiene Day.

CBM International Team Visits:

- Ms. Joyce Koech, Head of program CBM Inclusive Eye Health Initiative, visited LRBT on **10th may 2023**. She toured LRBT Korangi hospital and the CBM supported community block and ophthalmic skill enhancement resource lab. She also visited the LRBT Central Office, where she met the Honorary Chairman, CEO, COO of LRBT, and the program management team. The program manager of LRBT-CBM shared a presentation on the Inclusive Eye Health project, focusing on sustainability and future aspects.

- **Safeguarding training by Estrada Yhozhet, Global Safeguarding Advisor, CBM International**, was organized at LRBT Tertiary Teaching Hospital Korangi, Karachi. It was attended by CBM's safeguarding focal persons

across Pakistan, who also participated in conducting the safeguarding assessment of LRBT Hospital, Korangi Karachi.

FHF Cataract Surgeries



The Fred Hollows Foundation

The Fred Hollows Foundation (FHF) required LRBT to perform 2,530 sight-restoring cataract surgeries over a period of five months, from January to May 2023, at 5 LRBT designated hospitals. The target of 2,530 cataract surgeries was successfully achieved, and the project was completed on time.

A&A Company Formations DMCC – Dubai

During the period of April-June 2023, 1,858 under-privileged patients received Avastin injections across 13 LRBT Hospitals. A total of 10,383 Avastin injections are planned to be administered over the project period, from May 2023 to October 2024. These injections are being provided to patients who are unable to afford this treatment, and the cost is being financed by the Company.

LRBT takes this opportunity to express gratitude to A&A Company Formations-DMCC for sponsoring this charitable project.

Ebrahim Alibhai Charitable Trust

Under an arrangement with Ebrahim Ali Bhai Trust, LRBT conducts 375 sight-restoring cataract surgeries on a monthly basis at its North Karachi facility. This project was launched in January 2021. During the period from April to June 2023, LRBT conducted 1,125 surgeries. A total of 8,283 cataract surgeries have been conducted under this project so far.

LRBT extends its gratitude to the Ebrahim Ali Bhai Trust for their support of needy patients at LRBT North Karachi Hospital.

I-Care Foundation



In order to reduce preventable blindness among poor and needy male and female patients, I-Care Foundation entered into an agreement with LRBT

in June 2023 to conduct 550 cataract surgeries over the period June to July 2023. The hospital designated for this purpose is LRBT Pasrur. In June 2023, LRBT carried out 275 free cataract surgeries, and the same number of surgeries is planned for July 2023.

LRBT thanks I-Care Foundation for their support of needy patients and looks forward to further collaboration to help underprivileged individuals seeking eye care in Pakistan.

Human Relief Foundation (HRF)



Human Relief Foundation (HRF), a non-profit humanitarian organization based in the UK, signed a thirteen-month agreement with LRBT to implement cataract surgeries at LRBT Hospitals. As per the agreement, in June 2023, LRBT performed 250 free cataract surgeries for underprivileged and needy patients at Akora Khattak and Mansehra Hospitals.

Combat Blindness International



Combat Blindness International, a US-based non-profit organization, works in low-income regions of the world where visually impaired people have limited access to eye care or cannot afford it. LRBT and Combat Blindness International (CBI) collaborated on a project to conduct 1,675 cataract surgeries in Pakistan over the period July 2022 to June 2023. Four LRBT Hospitals, namely Lahore Multan Road, Khanewal, Mandra, and Chiniot, were selected for these surgeries. During this quarter, LRBT completed the balance of 478 surgeries to achieve the target of 1,675 surgeries. LRBT appreciates the support of CBI for these eye surgeries at the 4 LRBT Hospitals and looks forward to further collaboration with CBI to help underprivileged individuals avoid preventable blindness in Pakistan.

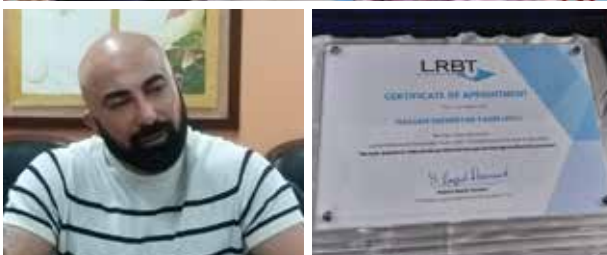

Heartfelt Condolences for the Dawood Family



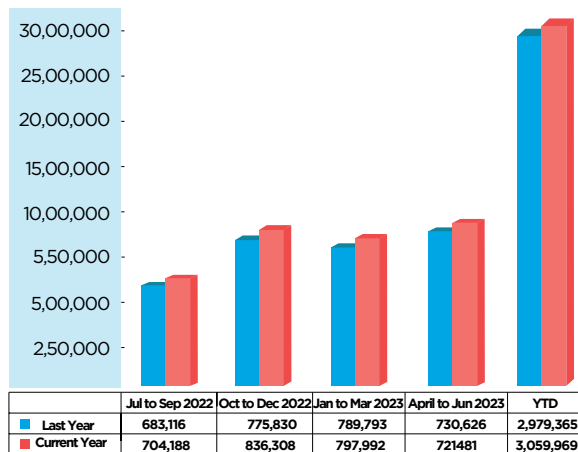

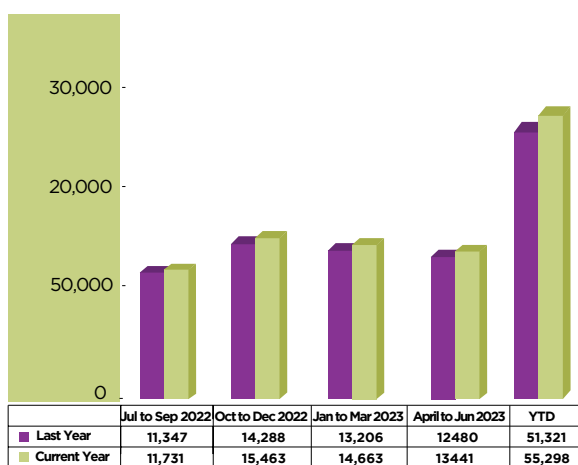

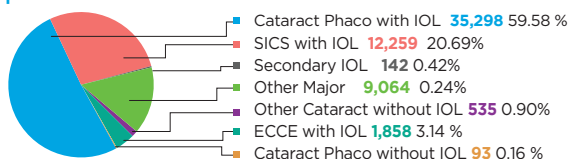
